"Hallmark Makes Your Life Easier"

The ANNOUNCER has a warm, affable voice not unlike the voiceovers for Disney trailers -- and is always offstage, speaking over a mic.

The onstage characters never speak aloud. If the stage directions indicate that they speak, they just mouth something silently.

LIGHTS UP on BOY and GIRL #1, at opposite ends of the stage.

ANNOUNCER Ah, romance. This time, you know it's going to last. This time, it's something special.

At the same time: the BOY looks at the GIRL bashfully. The GIRL tentatively waves back at him. Momentary eye contact, then both look away.

ANNOUNCER And now, you're looking for that special way to tell her how much you love her....

GIRL #2 pokes her head in from the wings, next to GIRL #1.

ANNOUNCER (cont'd) ... and her sister.

LIGHTS DOWN.

ANNOUNCER Because her sister... is hot.

LIGHTS UP on the BOY, sitting and looking mopey.

ANNOUNCER But asking for a three-way is the easiest thing in the world for everybody else but you.

LIGHTS DOWN as the BOY sighs.

ANNOUNCER

Sure, you've tried asking your parents for advice.

LIGHTS UP on a freeze-frame of BOY & GIRL #1 as parents, smiling knowingly at each other, while GIRL #2 looks off in the distance, grumpy. At the same time:

ANNOUNCER

They say it was easy in their day. But that was the 1980s, when everybody was binging on snowwhite Columbian blow.

LIGHTS DOWN.

ANNOUNCER

You have so many ways to communicate in this crazy, modern world, but does that make it any easier? When you talk, your throat goes dry.

LIGHTS UP on GIRL #1, looking at her cell phone.

ANNOUNCER

And somehow, text-messaging... just isn't classy enough.

At the same time: GIRL #1 rolls her eyes, snaps the phone shut, and puts it away.

LIGHTS DOWN.

LIGHTS UP on GIRL #1 and GIRL #2 pacing back and forth behind the BOY, who is bound up and laid out on the floor. BOY looks worried. At the same time:

ANNOUNCER And the internet... just attracts weirdos.

LIGHTS DOWN.

ANNOUNCER What *can* you do?

LIGHTS UP on BOY, walking to his mailbox. The BOY opens the mailbox, retrieves an envelope, opens it, looks at the card inside. At first he responds cheerfully, then he opens the card and his jaw drops a bit. At the same time:

ANNOUNCER

If only there were somebody out there to help you get your message across.

The BOY looks around to see if anybody is watching, then puts the card away in his jacket and skulks off stage.

LIGHTS DOWN.

At the same time:

ANNOUNCER

Fortunately, the good people at Hallmark are ready to help.

We then see several small vignettes. It would be desirable (but not 100% necessary) to light just the part of the stage that has a vignette going on.

ANNOUNCER

Hallmark's new "Party of Three" greeting cards will make your request for you with wit, and class, and sometimes an amusing photograph of a kitten.

At the same time: the BOY field-strips a weapon, then notices a card next to it. As she reads the card, GIRL #2 passes by, smiles, and gives him a macho pat on the back. Brief, awkward eye contact, with a "call me" gesture.

> ANNOUNCER We have cards appropriate to any profession...

At the same time: GIRL #1 as a surgeon. GIRL #2 hands her an implement, then a card. GIRL #1 reads the card, laughs cheerfully.

ANNOUNCER ... or any denomination.

At the same time: The BOY as the Pope. He's adjusting his hat, swinging a censer, and mumbling something in Latin.

ANNOUNCER So this time, try our new "Party of Three" greeting cards from Hallmark. It'll make your life... three times the fun!

At the same time: GIRL #1 and GIRL #2 cheerfully join the BOY (as Pope), who gathers up a girl in each arm. Pope thumbs up and smiles; everyone freezes.

(rapid-fire)
